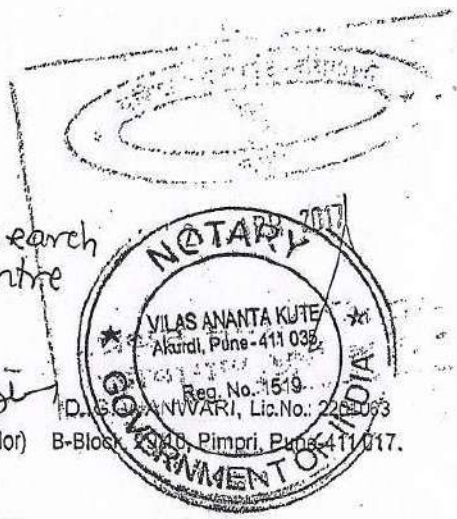

3. 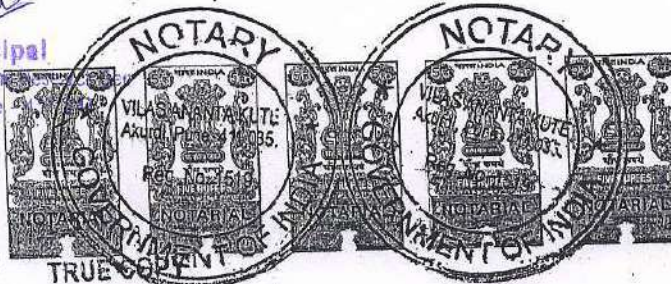

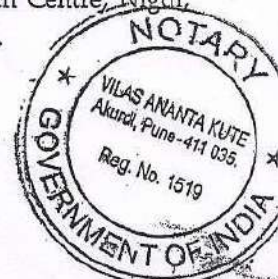

Post Graduate Students of Party No. 01, for the education purpose will be deputed in the said Critical Unit as per requisite of Party No. 1.

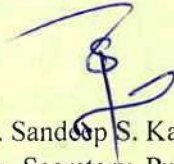

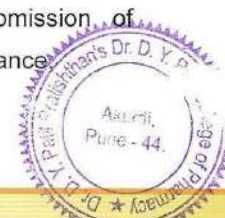

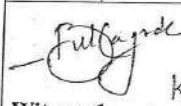

CLAUSE II

SCOPE OF THE MOU

2.2 Industrial Training & Visits: Industry (Production unit and Research Centre) and Institution Interaction will give an insight in to the latest developments / requirements of the industries: the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its facilities and also involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party. The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. 2.3 Research and Development:
Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the fields of Drug development and health sciences respecting each other's IPR rights.

2.4 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of, Whatsoever nature required for offering the Program on the terms specified herein.

2.5 There is no financial commitment on the part of the Ayush Ayurveda LLP, Pune, the Second Party to take up any program mentioned in the MOU.

CLAUSE 3

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4

VALIDITY

4.1 This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms.

4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligation.

CLAUSE 5

RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

5.1 It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as Independent service providers, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representation or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

WHEREAS, Pimpri Chinchwad Municipal Corporation is a corporate body constituted under the provision of Maharashtra Municipal Corporation Act (previously known as BPMC Act, 1949) and its Asst. Medical officer of health having the authority to execute contracts on behalf of the Corporation whereas the Corporation owns and manages various hospitals within its territorial jurisdiction.

And

Whereas PDEA's College of Ayurved & Research Centre, Nigdi, Pune - 411044 is the college / institute established in the year 1990 constituted Under the provision of recognition by Central Council of Indian Medicine 3-14/91-Ayu(24), Dtd.14.10.1993 & Government of Maharashtra Vide G.R.No.ADR/1689/ 2398/ CR248/ 89/M-Edu-7,Dtd.19.06.1990 of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, given powers to its Principal to enter into agreement vide order / resolution dated 12.12.2017 for affording practical training of students of the B.A.M.S. courses at Pimpri Chinchwad municipal corporation's PCMC Post Graduate Institute & Yashwantrao Chavan Memorial Hospital, Pimpri, Pune.

And Whereas Medical Education and Drugs Dept. of Govt. of Maharashtra vide order Dated 08/10/2003 decided to levy deposit for collages / institutes willing to complete internship for their students in Government Hospital also vide order Dated 12/12/2017 confirmed the charges for such student on per day per Bed basis.

And Whereas relied upon the above order of Govt. of Maharashtra, Standing Committee of the Party of the First Part vide Resolution No 7334 Dated 12/08/2020 accord its sanction to levy these charges for the students who opt for completion of internship in PCMC Hospitals. And whereas as per the decision and standing committee Commissioner, PCMC issued an order in this regard vide order no. Med/1/WS/1316/2020 dated 17/09/2020.

Now therefore following terms and conditions have been prescribed and those have been accepted by both the parties.

1. The party & the second Party has paid deposit Rs.125000/- (vide cheque/DD no. 025624 dated -22/06/2016; receipt no B/287, dated-12.07.2016.

The Corporation hereby allows the party of the second part to make use of PCMC's Post Graduate Institute & Yashwantrao Chavan Memorial Hospital, Pimpri, Pune.

2. Hospital to impart practical training to its Interns . The Corporation will not pay any remuneration to students on this account. The College/ Interns will not claim any type of fund or grant from the Corporation for this educational activity.
3. After completion of Degree Course (UG) by the students, Corporation will accommodate them in the said hospital for their internship (The said fees will be paid as per the rate prescribed by the Govt. of Maharashtra vide GR No. MED-1602/CR.382/01/Edu-2 Dated-08/01/2003 as Rs.4500/- per intern per month).
4. It is also agreed by the party of the second part to pay 10% rise every year as mentioned in the GR dated 12/12/2017 of Medical Education and Drugs Department of Govt. of Maharashtra.
5. In consideration for the facility of practical training made available, party of the second part will pay the affiliation fees to the Corporation from 29.07.2021.
6. It is agreed by party of the second part to pay Rs.150/- (Rupees One Hundred Fifty only) per students/per day/per bed from 29/07/2021 to 29/07/2024 will be paid as clinical exposure fees. (As per the rate prescribed by the Govt. of Maharashtra, No. HSP-2015/196/Shikana/Edu-1 Dated- 12/12/2017)
7. The concern Medical Superintendent / In-charge Medical Officer of PCMC's Hospital will do day to day supervision.
8. The clinical instructors/ clinical tutor, Pune will do the day today supervision during posting in concern hospital.
9. Party of the Second part, will ensure that the students will maintain discipline during the tenure of training in the hospital.
10. Party of the Second part has to ensure that the student should attend the hospital regularly and on time for the duty hours.
11. This MOU is valid for period of 3 years from date of its execution.
12. Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik and College practical examinations for final year BAMS students & Interns will be conducted on timely basis. 15 days prior notice will be given for such examination. Similarly Govt. of Maharashtra, Maharashtra State OT-PT Council, and Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik members shall visit for inspection. The YCMH staff should extend support services and cooperation.

RENEWAL AGREEMENT OF LAB SERVICES

This LAB SERVICES AGREEMENT (hereinafter referred to as "Agreement") is made and entered at Pune on this 27 day of October, 2021 by and between:

SRL Limited, a company incorporated under the Companies Act, 1956, and having its registered office at Plot No. D-3, A-Wing, 2nd Floor, District Centre, Saket, New Delhi-110017, acting through its collection center Mr Sachin Kshirsagar, Manager, Samarth Diagnostic Services, hereinafter referred to as "SRL" (which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context and meaning thereof, include its successors in interest and permitted assigns) of the First Part;

AND

Ayurved Rugnalaya & Sterling Multispecialty Hospital, a Hospital established under Pune Dist. Education Association under the provisions of Bombay Public Trust Act having its registered office at Erandwana , Pune - 411038, acting through its Authorized signatory, Dr. Ragini Patil, Supritendent hereinafter referred to as **"Ayurved Rugnalaya & Sterling Multispecialty Hospital"** (which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context and meaning thereof, include its successors in interest and permitted assigns) of the Second Part;

("SRL" and **"Ayurved Rugnalaya & Sterling Multispecialty Hospital"** shall herein wherever the context may so require, be collectively referred to as **"Parties"** and individually as a **"Party"**.)

WHEREAS:

1. AYURVED RUGNALAYA & STERLING MULTISPECIALTY HOSPITAL is engaged in the business of providing medical & patient care services and has established and manages IPD and OPD patient care in its hospital situated at Sector 27 ,Pradhikaran Nigdi, Pune - 411044.
2. SRL is engaged in the business of conducting and providing large range of diagnostic tests throughout India from its multi-speciality laboratories situated in various parts of the country through well trained and highly qualified staff and has deployed latest machinery, gadgets and computer software for conducting diagnostic test in order to maintain a high level of quality. SRL has also obtained accreditation and certifications for its lab from various national and international bodies including NABL and CAP.
3. AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECIALTY HOSPITAL has expressed its desire to avail the laboratory services from SRL through its collection center Samarth Diagnostic Services on non exclusive basis and SRL has agreed to provide the same and accordingly Parties are now desirous of entering into this Agreement to record their mutual agreement and understanding subject to terms and conditions as set out herein.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

Definitions and Interpretation

The following words and terms used in this Agreement shall have the meanings ascribed to them, wherever they appear:

"Agreement" means this Agreement and any Schedules and/or Annexures/ Appendices accompanying it and any modifications made after mutual consent of both the Parties in writing.

"Confidential Information" means and includes any and all information/data which is confidential to a Party including but not limited to (i) any business information, business strategies and plans,(ii) advertising and marketing plans or marketing information, data and/or material, (iii) any past, current or proposed development projects or plans for future development work, (iv) any technical, marketing, financial and commercial information, (v) data/information in respect of Patients, (vi) the commercial and business affairs of a Party, and (vii) all other related information including any rates, payment terms and discounts.

1. Scope of Service

During the tenure of this Agreement, AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL shall, at its sole discretion, send such samples collected from the Patients to SRL that require pathology tests for which:

- (a) There is no facility for carrying such test/service within the Hospital of AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL; or
- (b) Although the facility is available within Hospital but due to non - availability on a temporary basis the AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL cannot carry out such tests; or
- (c) The LH wants any confirmatory tests.

Upon receipt of such samples, SRL hereby agrees either to carryout/conduct necessary tests by itself or get it tested at such other laboratory as agreed between the Parties from time to time.

2. Tenure

Subject to the termination clause mentioned hereinafter, this Agreement shall remain in force for a period of **5 (Five) Year commencing and effective from 27th October, 2021 and expiring on 31st October, 2026** unless otherwise renewed on such terms and conditions and for such period as mutually agreed between the Parties in writing.

3. Collection of Sample and Transportation

- (a) AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL shall organize to collect the sample for testing from the Patients and shall assume full responsibility for the sample collection process at its Hospital including adequate quantity of sample/specimen for conducting the respective tests.
- (b) SRL shall, at its own cost, provide the necessary packaging materials such as specimen vials, styrofoam containers, corrugated boxes and/or such other materials as mutually agreed from time to time in writing ("Materials") to AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL for collection of samples from its Patients. AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL shall maintain and provide all necessary records of Material consumed which shall be provided as and when desired by SRL without delay and simultaneously return the remaining Material at the expiry or earlier termination of the Agreement to SRL.
- (c) AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL undertakes that the Patient's specimens/samples referred to SRL's laboratory are collected in appropriate containers and shall preserve the samples with due care and caution before sending the same to SRL's Laboratory.
- (d) SRL shall, at its own cost, arrange for the transportation of the samples to be collected from AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY

HOSPITAL at a mutually convenient time and day. Further, AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL shall while providing the sample/specimen to SRL undertakes to provide clear instructions and all necessary information with regard to type / nature of test required to be carried out at SRL's Laboratory for the respective sample/specimen.

- (e) In case of any unforeseen delay due to reasons beyond the reasonable control of either party, the integrity of the collected samples may be compromised and in such situation other samples may be requested by SRL and AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL agrees to provide the same to SRL on request.

4. Reporting

- (a) Reporting of the samples shall be in accordance with the Turn Around Time ("TAT") mentioned in the reference guide of SRL. SRL shall be excused from performance and shall not be liable for any delay in delivery or non-delivery, in whole or in part, caused by the occurrence of any contingency beyond the control of its including, but not limited to, leakage and contamination of sample, work stoppages, natural calamity, civil disobedience, riots, fire accidents, shortage of fuel, diplomatic impasse, lost of sample, and Act of God. SRL shall however make all reasonable efforts to perform once the event ceases to exist.
- (b) However, for all reports requiring physical reporting like graphs, slides, blocks etc., the same shall be delivered by SRL logistics physically to AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL.
- (c) In case of extreme situation when there is some error or problem with relation to downloading of the reports from ID, then AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL shall intimate the same to SRL and SRL shall make arrangement for the physical delivery of the reports through its logistics department as per applicable TAT till the time the error or problem is fixed.

5. Price List, Testing Charges & Discount

- (a) SRL hereby agrees to grant below mentioned discount to AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL:

- (i) **For Domestic**

- I. During the term of this Agreement, in all referral sample cases tested by SRL at its laboratory except such tests as specified in **Annexure A**, SRL shall offer Flat Discount of 12% (twelve percent) on MRP of the respective tests to AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL as per SRL's Directory of Services.
- II. In respect of tests enlisted in Annexure A, SRL shall charge from AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL the corresponding Price as specified against the respective tests in **Annexure A** to this Agreement.

- (ii) **For Overseas**

All investigations carried out in International send-outs, SRL shall offer Flat Discount of 2% (Seven percent) on MRP of such test to AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL.

- (b) For the purposes of arriving at the actual charges payable by AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL to SRL under this Agreement, SRL shall furnish to AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL, schedule of charges under various package(s) under this Agreement and keep the AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL informed about any revision in the Charges, which may take place from time to time. AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL agrees that Prices are subject to change from time to time based on input costs and market considerations.
- (c) Billing cycle: Invoices of all the tests shall be raised by SRL on a monthly basis. AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL shall pay the invoiced amount to SRL within 15(fifteen) days from the date of the invoice(s), subject to applicable taxes. All such payments shall be made by cheque in favour of "Samarth Diagnostic Services". Delayed payment beyond 15 days from the date of invoice shall attract interest @ 24% per annum.

6. Termination

Notwithstanding anything contained above, this Agreement may be terminated by either Party by giving 30 (thirty) days prior written notice to the other without assigning any reason stating its intention to terminate and the Agreement shall stand terminated after the expiry of such notice period.

The expiry/termination of this Agreement will be without prejudice to any rights that either Party may have accrued against the other prior to termination.

7. Consequences of Termination

- i. Upon expiry or termination of this Agreement as detailed above, all rights granted shall terminate automatically and immediately and both the Parties shall forthwith handover to each other or its authorized agents / personnel all the confidential information, intellectual property, materials, data base and other documents and records including its soft copies, if any, pertaining to this Agreement and belonging to each other..
- ii. All payments becoming due and payable to SRL as on the date of termination/expiration under the terms of this Agreement shall continue to be due and payable to SRL notwithstanding the termination/expiration hereof. AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECILTY HOSPITAL undertakes to pay all the outstanding(s) to SRL within 15(fifteen) days of termination/expiration of this Agreement.

8. Representation and Warranties

- (a) Both the Parties represent and warrant that they have all the corporate, regulatory, legal and other authorizations and licenses to carry on and conduct their respective activities and to execute this Agreement in accordance with applicable laws and that

execution of this Agreement and performance of this Agreement does not and will not breach or cause conflict with any other obligations to any third party.

- (b) It is mutually agreed between the Parties that, neither party will interfere in the procedure/protocol of the other in connection with the collection of sample, its storage and testing. It is further agreed that, neither party shall have any liability or responsibility of whatsoever nature towards the Patients for any acts and omissions of the staff/employees/personnel of the other Party.

9. Confidentiality

- (i) Both Parties shall maintain utmost confidentiality and take all due and reasonable care and diligence in ensuring the protection of all Confidential Information, which in no case shall be less than the degree of care taken to protect and safeguard confidential or proprietary information.
- (ii) Both Parties shall not use/disclose/publish/sell/transfer any of Confidential Information for any purpose whatsoever during the term of this Agreement except as agreed between the Parties in writing for the performance of its obligations under the Agreement or with the prior written consent of the Disclosing Party. However, this shall not apply to any Confidential Information that is (a) in the possession of, or was known to, the recipient prior to its receipt, without an obligation to maintain its confidentiality; (b) becomes generally known to the public without violation of this Agreement; (c) obtained by recipient from a third party having the right to disclose it, without the obligation to keep such information confidential; (d) independently developed by recipient without the use of Confidential Information; and (e) required to be provided under any law, or process of law duly executed.

10. Intellectual Property

- (i) All intellectual property including but not limited to trademark, logo, slogans, marks, labels whether registered or not, shall be the sole property of Party having its ownership and neither Party shall be authorized by virtue of anything contained in this Agreement to use or exploit in any manner whatsoever any intellectual property owned by the other Party, except as may be mutually agreed between the Parties for the purposes of this Agreement.
- (ii) SRL's logo, trademark etc. is owned by SRL. Nothing in this Agreement authorizes or permits AYURVED RUGNALAY & STERLING MULTISPECIALTY HOSPITAL to use SRL's logo, product logo or any trademark without its prior written including but not limited to displaying/use of SRL's logo or trademark on its website, in any campaign or other public disclosure.

11. Governing Law and Dispute Resolution

- (a) Jurisdiction and Applicable Laws

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India and Courts/Tribunals at Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction to decide all matters arising out of or in connection with this Agreement.

- (b) Dispute Resolution/Arbitration

- i) All or any disputes or differences arising from this Agreement or any matter connected therewith shall be settled amicable between the Parties.
- ii) If no amicable settlement is arrived at within 30 days from the date of reference of dispute/difference by either Party to the other Party, then any Party may refer the dispute to sole arbitrator to be nominated and appointed by SRL. 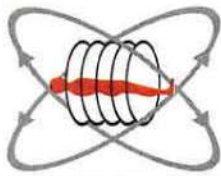

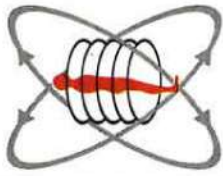

Ltd., Mumbai/Pune and as whereas 'TIMER' has approached and discussed with 'PDEACARC' to undertake the clinical trials as referred above as per Protocol No. AP/VJT/SBO/01/2022, Version no. 1.0 Dated 26th Feb 2022. Now the terms of this M.O.U. witness as under –

1. The Objectives of the study shall be –

The objective of the study is to evaluate the efficacy and safety of AP/VJT/SBO Ayurvedic Hair Oil in mild to moderate Hair loss in females.

2. Study outcomes of the study shall be -

1. Primary Outcome:

- a. Comparative assessment of hair fall in AP/VJT/SBO Ayurvedic hair oil by running finger test over a period of 60 days.
- b. Comparative assessment of hair breakage in AP/VJT/SBO Ayurvedic hair oil by comb test over a period of 60 days.

2. Secondary outcomes:

- a. Comparative assessment of hair fall in AP/VJT/SBO Ayurvedic hair oil by Hair Pull test over a period of 60 days
- b. Comparative assessment of hair growth in AP/VJT/SBO Ayurvedic hair oil by comparing against standard infrequent hair oil users
- c. Comparative assessment of effect of AP/VJT/SBO Ayurvedic hair oil on dandruff in females by standard dandruff evaluation cards

9. Subjects who have participated in any other clinical study since last 3 months

7. After getting clearance from the Ethical Committee for this clinical study, the subjects attending the O.P.D. at 'PDEACARC' at Nigadi, Pune meeting inclusion criteria and voluntarily written consents, will be recruited for the study at O.P.D. basis. Patients (subjects) will be selected on screening visit and written informed consent will be taken from subjects for their participation in the study.

8. Treatment Plan:

Exposure to Investigational product shall be given to only those subjects who meet the inclusion/exclusion criteria. All screened subjects shall be entered into the screening log. Subjects who meet the inclusion/exclusion criteria shall be recruited in the study.

Recruited subjects shall be allotted a unique subject number and the number shall be entered in the enrolment log. If a subject drops out of the study after allocation of the unique subject number, that number shall not be re-allocated to another subject.

14. Procedures to be performed daily during study treatment

After Ethics committee's clearance for the clinical study and subsequent registration of clinical trial at CTRI website, subjects attending OPD meeting inclusion criteria and ready to provide written informed consent for participation in the study, will be recruited in the study. The treatment will be given on OPD basis. 20 subjects with in mild to moderate Hair loss in females will be screened for eligibility criteria to get 20 evaluable cases at the end of the study.

On screening visit, written informed consent will be obtained from the subjects for their participation in the study. Subject's history will be recorded and her physical examination will be done. Assessment of inclusion and exclusion criteria will be done. Assessment of hair loss will be done and those subjects having mild to moderate hair loss (40-140 Hair by Comb test, Running Finger Test) will be included in the study.
