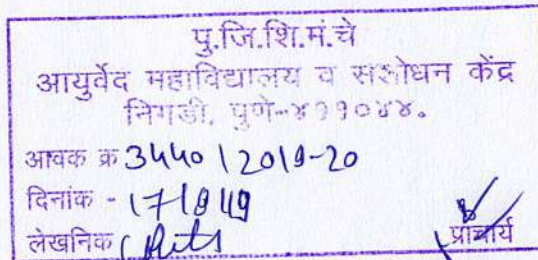

Ladies got opportunity to listen to special lecture on the subject of female health by the Speaker – Dr.Anjali V.Jadhav- H.O.D Streerog Dept.
- 2) Medical health check-up camp in PDEA's Primary school was arranged at Dehu road on 13-3-2020. Time- 9.00 to 1.00 pm. In PDEA's Shri. Shivaji Primary school, at Dehu Road, Pune. During health check-up camp students from 1st to 4th class were checked. All students were treated with medicines. 150 school students were examined by the expert consultants and medicines were given to the ill students. Propagation of prevention of COVID 19 disease was done for the students and the teachers. The school premise was cleaned. Tree plantation was done in the school campus.
