Institute adopts following measures for midcourse improvement.

- Problem solving- Every department put one analytical question on Google classroom and students answer it.
- MUHS Paper solving and written assignments are taken from students to improve writing skills and time management skills in students.
- Revision of theory & Practical.
- Non lecture activities like student's seminar, group discussion, shloka recitation, Quiz etc.
