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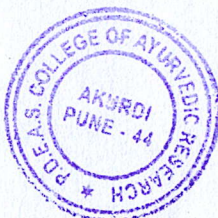

Methods of Assessment of Learning Outcome & Graduate attributes

- Program outcomes are analysed by formative and summative evaluation methods.
- Continuous internal evaluation is done as per the academic calendar.
- Student's academic growth is monitored and analysed in the internal and university examination.
- To assess Practical skills UG students maintain journals, herbarium and PG students maintain log books and journals and project record.
- Students are classified into slow and advanced learners on the basis of their performance in internal examinations.
- Teachers follow special program as per the policy of institution.
- Teachers follow various methods like problem based learning, assignments, quizzes, case based learning, OSCE, group discussions, role play, classroom presentations.

Method of Assessments of learning domain for UG students

- Cognitive domain is assessed on the basis of SAQ, LAQ and Viva verse.
- Affective domain is assessed on the basis of active participation in curricular and extracurricular activity, competition and NSS activities.
- Psychomotor domain is assessed on the basis of practical skills, clinical skills, systemic examination etc. in the form of short case, long case.





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Method of Assessments of PG scholars

- Pre PG scholars prepare synopsis on research project of the concerned subject. Assessment is done through University Theory and practical examination.
- PG students maintain log book and journals.
- Scholars participate and present assigned topics in the departmental seminars.
- Project work/dissertation is prepared and submitted to university by final year PG students.
- Final assessment is done on the basis of Dissertation, Conferences attended, Paper/ poster presentations in National/ International Conferences, Research Paper publications, topic presentation, case taking and presentation and performance in University Theory and practical examination.

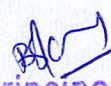
Method of Assessments of Ph.D. scholars:

- Ph.D. scholars are assessed on the basis of course work which carries credits. It includes assignments, University approved workshop on Advanced Research Methodology, research publication Pre Ph.D. exam (Theory and Viva), six monthly progress reports and Thesis.

Method of Assessments of Fellowship courses:

- Assessment is done through viva voce and project/Research presentation.
