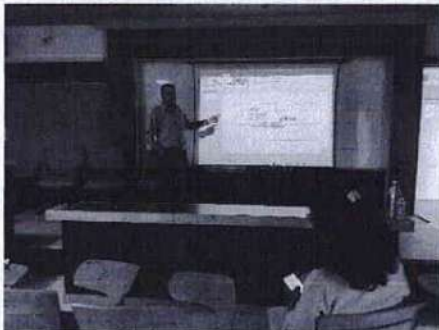

Guest speaker has very vast experience of in the various fields of the research along with bioethics. Hence to enrich the knowledge on bioethics a webinar was organized by the department.



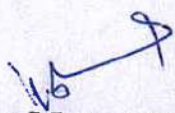

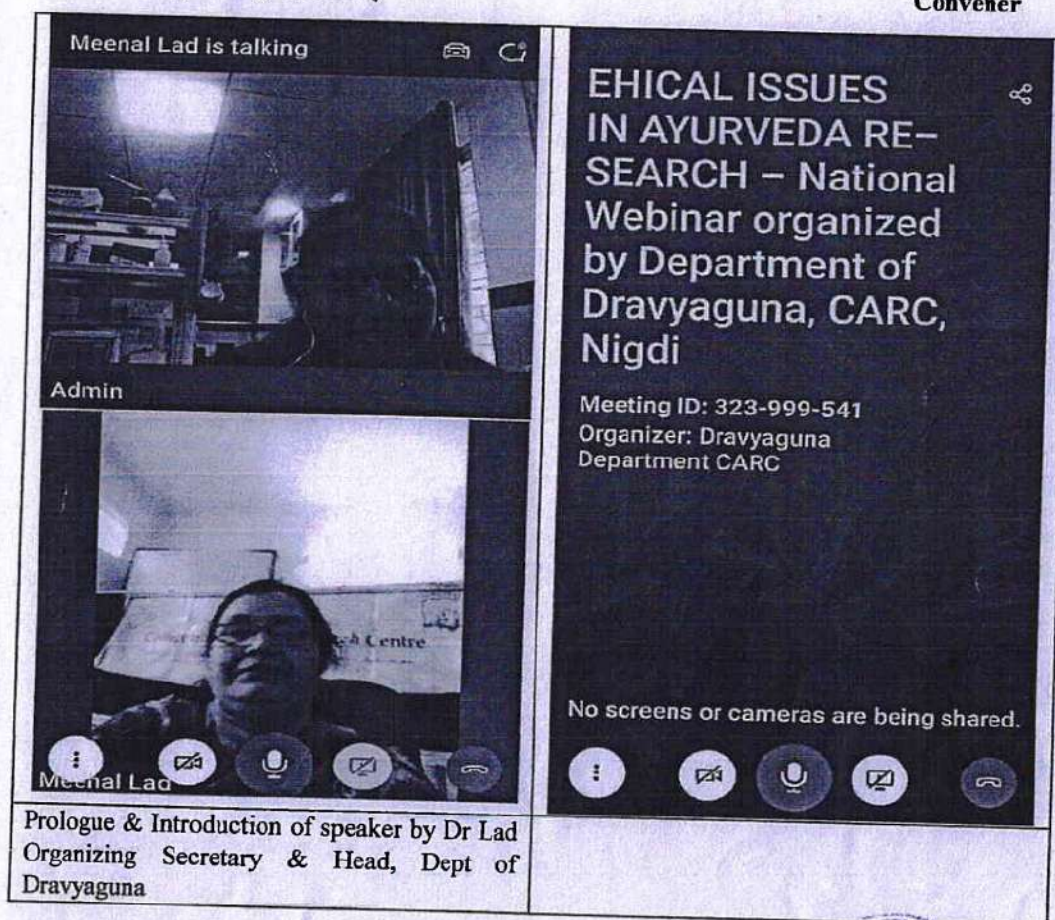

Time – 2.30 to 4 pm

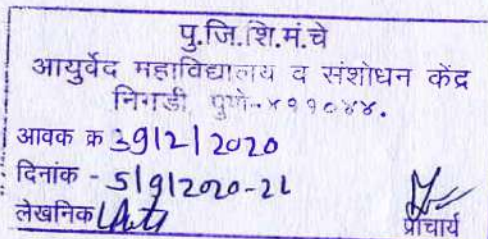
The resource person explained the requirements for grant research projects starting from 'how to write a research protocol and how to maintain each document related to the project in detail'.

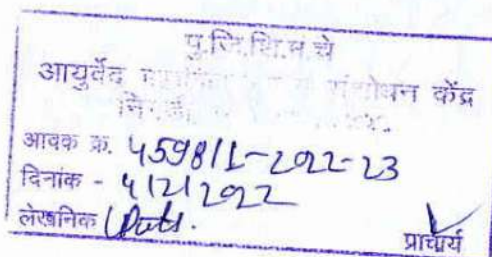

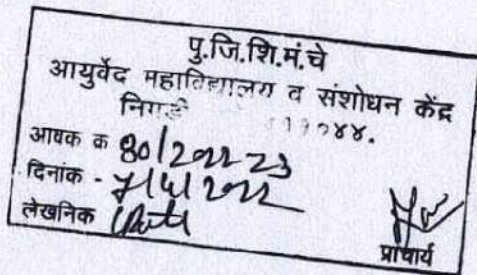

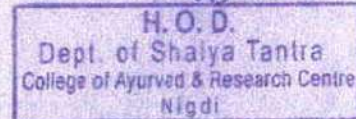

Basic Workshop in Health Sciences Education Technology-

23rd to 25th March 2023

The **Basic Workshop in Health Sciences Education Technology** was organized by our institute on 23rd to 25th March 2023 at P.D.E.A's College of Ayurved and Research Centre Nigdi Pune 44. As per M.U.H.S./MET guidelines, the sessions were organised for three days from morning 09.00- 16.00.

The twenty nine delegates were registered & attended the workshop. The detailed list is attached with the report. 29 teachers were from our college. Six faculty members were invited as resource person for the workshop. Four faculties from Sumatibhai Shah Ayurved Mahavidyalaya Hadapsar as Dr. Maya Gokhle, Dr. Neelakshi Pradhan, Dr. Kavita Deshmukh and Dr. Anand Kalaskar, one faculty from National Institute of Nutrition Pune Dr. Shrikanth Muralidharan & Myself

The auditorium was well organized with five tables with six-six chairs were kept around the table. On each table prearranged with one water bottle and bowl filled with Nutramla. Study session hand-outs file were distributed per group. Online daily feedback was taken on iast session on concern days

On 23rd March 2023 the workshop was started at 9.20 am The program was started with Dhanwantari poojan and stavan.

The pre-test link was shared to all the delegates email and 20 minutes were given for solving. The first session was started by me. With distributing 15 mango leaves, seizer and string one toran activity was taken among the participants for team building. First video was shown to participant how to make toran. Then time required to prepare toran was noted. The group 3rd was the winner prepared toran in 6 .12 minutes. I have conducted **Ice Breaking and Group Dynamics**. This session ended on 10 .00 am. Next lecture started on 11.45 on **Curriculum, Outcomes and Objectives** by Dr. Maya Gokhale , what are the teaching points should be covered with various angles were enumerated on flip chart. After the lecture the activity was given that prepare the objectives based on different domains from your concern subjects. The morning session ends with lunch. In Pre MCQ test Dr. Anuja Waddekar from Agadtantra department was first topper by 14 marks out of 20 , second topper Dr Vrinda Kurande form Kayachikitsa department by 12 marks out of 20 .

The afternoon session was taken by Dr. Mrs. Neelakshi Pradhan Madam on **Communication Skills** at 2.00 pm. Madam has used many movie clips for showing different communication skills. Session started with role play. Madam has also performed one role play of doctor and patient

communication in that she has presented one doctor & patient miss-communication so that audience could understand that how the communication should be performed with the patients. 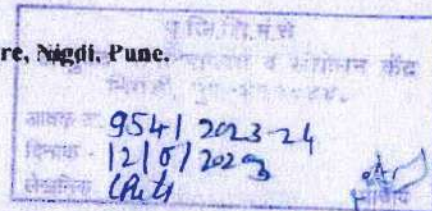

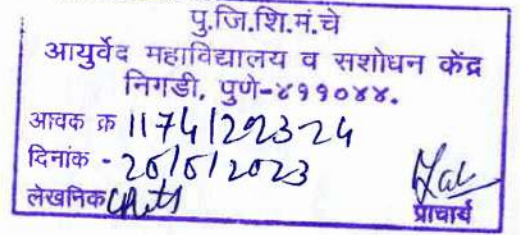
