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### Strategic Plan of Academic Committee

#### Introduction:

Pune District Education Association is our alma mater under whose Patronage College of Ayurved and Research Centre, Nigdi, Pune has flourished in last three decades. Our institute is recognized by ministry of AYUSH and National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM, New Delhi). It is affiliated to Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik, Maharashtra.

The institution offers UG, PG, Ph.D. Programs and Fellowship courses in our institute. Bachelor of Ayurved Medicine and Surgery (BAMS) is offered for undergraduate students who want to pursue career in holistic science of Ayurved. Institution also offers post-graduation in 14 subjects of Ayurved. College is acknowledged as official center for Ph.D. in 10 subjects of Ayurveda and it also provides platform to graduates in Ayurveda for fellowship courses. All these programs which are offered by the institute follow the curriculum designed by authorities like AYUSH, NCISM and MUHS.

NCISM, New Delhi has implemented competency based curriculum in 2021-2022. This curriculum focuses on development of professional skills in students. It has prescribed program and course outcomes with clear guidelines regarding course objectives mentioning domains and levels of integration. To implement this curriculum as guided by MES, 2024 dated 1<sup>st</sup> May 2024, revision in previous existing College Curriculum Committee. As per the above mentioned guidelines, representatives from all the departments are included for smooth facilitation of curriculum planning, execution and monitoring.

#### Aims and Objectives:

1. To implement curriculum prescribed by NCISM and MUHS
2. To ensure effective curriculum planning
3. To monitor effective delivery of curriculum
4. To prepare plan for evaluation





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**Composition:** The Academic Committee is an integrated body consisting of representatives of all subjects of professional years and coordinators allotted to various programs.

## **FUNCTIONS:**

1. Academic Committee functions in accordance with the NCISM and MUHS academic guidelines for the overall planning and implementation of curriculum of BAMS, MD / MS and other courses conducted in our institute.
2. **For UG and PG:**
  - a. To frame time table in accordance with lecture and non-lecture hours as allotted by NCISM and MUHS.
  - b. Coordination with individual department regarding ATPs which are prepared by individual departments covering all topics allotted in their respective subject in stipulated period.
  - c. To monitor whether the delivery of theory lectures, practical (non lectures –theory and practical) and clinical postings are adhering to syllabus prescribed by NCISM and





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is competency based.

- d. To monitor whether this ATPs are being followed by conducting internal audit after every term end exams.
  - e. To conduct internal examinations (Evaluation) as per the exam pattern prescribed by NCISM and MUHS. (For UG only)
  - f. For postgraduate student's submission of progress report to evaluate completion of dissertation work, house post and mandatory curricular activities like seminars, research paper publication, paper/ poster presentation and UG lectures conducted by post graduate students.
3. **For Ph.D.:** To conduct coursework and thesis work as per MUHS guidelines. Progress reports are mandatory for all PhD enrolled students every six monthly and minimum six progress reports should be submitted.
  4. **For Fellowship courses:** To conduct Fellowship course as per MUHS guidelines.
  5. To review the ongoing process and to discuss any modifications needed in the current programs; meeting is conducted every 3 monthly.
  6. To review suggestions obtained in feedback on curriculum or syllabus.
  7. To suggest appropriate actions on the above suggestions and monitor implementation.

### Roles and Responsibilities:

#### ❖ Chairman:

1. To monitor all academic activities conducted in the institution.
2. Grievance redressal regarding curriculum.

#### ❖ Academic Director:

1. To keep vigilance on all UG activities conducted in all academic years. Whether guidelines prescribed in curriculum of each professional year is being followed.
2. To prepare academic calendar with the help of academic coordinators.





❖ **PG Academic Director:**

1. To prepare plan of action for post graduate students.
2. To monitor research related work of synopsis and dissertation.
3. To assess progress through progress reports of final year postgraduate students every six monthly.

❖ **Ph.D. coordinator:**

1. To plan coursework and monitor thesis work.
2. To assess progress through progress reports of PhD students every six monthly.

❖ **UG Academic Coordinators:**

1. To frame timetable of their respective academic years (professionals) as per norms of NCISM and MUHS.
2. To collect ATP from all departments regarding, lecture, non-lecture, clinical postings & proposed educational visits at the beginning of every academic year.
3. To conduct internal audit at the end of term.
4. To report fallacies observed in internal audit to college curriculum committee and to take necessary actions on defaulters if any.
5. To prepare schedule of term wise internal examination as per NCISM and MUHS norms with the help of exam cell.

❖ **Representatives of all subjects of professional years**

1. To co-ordinate with UG Academic Coordinators, PG Academic Director and Ph.D. coordinator for smooth conduction of all programs.

❖ **Fellowship course coordinator:**

1. To monitor smooth conducting of fellowship certificate courses.

❖ **Academic Committee Secretary:**





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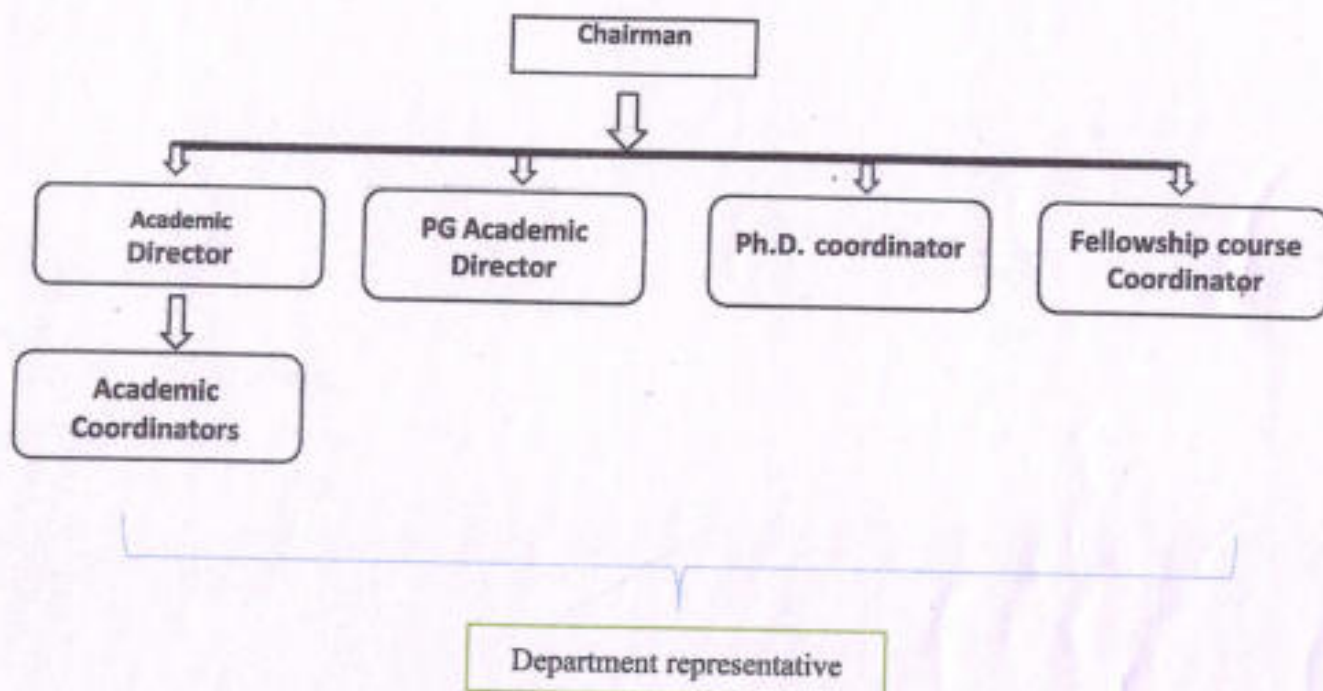

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### SOP/ STRATEGIC PLAN:

The institute adopts the curriculum prescribed by the respective regulatory councils i.e. AYUSH & NCISM and the affiliating University i.e. MUHS, Nashik. The institute ensures effective curriculum planning, delivery and evaluation. For this purpose, the institute has established college curriculum committee.

### UG /BAMS :

#### 1. Curriculum Planning:

- a. **Advance Teaching Planner (ATP):** Subject wise distribution of topics of curriculum of concern year is done by H.O.D. of the concern department to each faculty according to their strength and specialty. The faculty members have to prepare month wise ATP of their subject topics, before commencement of academic year. Coordinator of concern year collects the ATP from each department. Teaching schedules are planned one month prior and displayed on websites and Learning management system.
- b. **Timetable:** Coordinators of concern academic year prepare timetables before academic year commences. Changes are also made from time to time according to the need. Timetable of theory, practical (non-lectures) & clinical posting (as per concern year) is prepared as per the guidelines prescribed by NCISM, MUHS regarding subject wise theory and practical hours allotment.
- c. **Internal Audit:** Committee members of curriculum committee keep vigilance that teachers are completing topics according to ATP & following timetable. There is internal audit of ATP at the end of every term. Teachers mark the topics they have covered in particular term as per expected schedule & also mention about incomplete portion with satisfactory explanation. Coordinators also collect same information from student representative. Both collected information is counter checked.





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### 2. Curriculum Delivery:

Different types of media are used to deliver curriculum topics. Following tools are being used currently in this institution:

- a. **Lectures:** Teachers can use blackboard or LCD projectors or power point presentations during their lectures.
- b. **Learning Management System (LMS):** Institute has developed LMS , all teachers share various resources and activities wherever required as per the syllabus.
- c. **Museums:** Well-maintained museums are also used to deliver curriculum topics. Charts, specimens, models available in museum are effective media to deliver knowledge.
- d. **Laboratory:** Practical in labs is also an effective media to deliver curriculum. Demonstrations, in hand practical are effective media to improve student's knowledge.
- e. **Clinical postings:** Clinical postings are also one of the effective media to deliver curriculum. As B.A.M.S. is a professional course, actual field work is important to improve student's knowledge.
- f. Field visit, medical camps, exhibitions, NSS activities are also arranged to supplement effective delivery of curriculum. These are planned for every academic year.
- g. **Slow Learner and Advance Achiever:** Slow Learner and Advance Achiever are identified. Various methods for improvements have been identified and activities are conducted regularly in each department.





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### 3. Curriculum Evaluation:

Evaluation of curriculum delivered to students is done in following ways:

- Guidelines prescribed in NCISM syllabus are implemented as per the course objectives.
- Internal assessment: schedule of periodicals and term end tests are followed strictly for academic batches 2021-2022 onward as prescribed by NCISM and MUHS.
- For improvement and practice, activities are regularly conducted throughout the academic year.
- Problem solving question (based on curriculum) of each department is shared with students in LMS/ Google classroom. This helps in development of problem centric understanding and thinking capacity of students.
- Student's feedback is also one of the effective tools of evaluation of whether curriculum is delivered effectively. In this institute student's feedback regarding teachers is taken at the time of two term end examinations.
- Progress of the students is communicated with the parents through the medium of Parent – Teacher's Meetings after each term.





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**PG:** for postgraduate student's same guidelines as per UG are followed for lectures and practical, clinical work (house post). But more emphasis is given on research methodology, synopsis and dissertation work. As per the prescribed syllabus of individual course facilities of trainings in pharmacy or modern unit are provided to the students. Rules and regulations prescribed by MUHS, Nashik regarding lectures, seminars, study tour, field visit, presentations and article publication by PG students are strictly followed and assessed in every six monthly progress report by PG director.

**Ph.D.:** For conduction of Ph.D. program, Ph.D. direction 01-2020 of MUHS is followed. According to this direction, Ph.D. student after enrollment should complete coursework within one semester. 16 credits coursework is compulsory for completion. Progress of PhD students is monitored by Research Advisory Committee every six monthly.

**Fellowship courses:** Fellowship courses are type of skill development program offered to Ayurved graduate. These courses are conducted as per the direction of these courses by MUHS (Direction No: 05/2017 (Amended)). More emphasis is given on hands on training of these candidates. Examination is carried out as per the MUHS guidelines.





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### Feedback for curriculum:

Feedback for curriculum is obtained from students, teachers, professional, alumni and employers. Google forms are used for this purpose. Feedbacks are obtained once in a year. Analysis of these feedbacks is done and suggestions received are presented in meetings of college curriculum committee.

### Conduction of Meetings:

Meetings for planning and review are scheduled every three months. All records of these meetings are preserved. In this meeting points related to planning of academic year, timetable, ATP and schedule of examinations are discussed. To assess effective delivery of curriculum; attendance of students to theory and practical hours, their results in internal assessment and MUHS final exam is also reviewed.

Feedback for curriculum is collected from various stakeholders. Its analysis and suggestions received are discussed in the meeting. Suggestions which are specific to planning and delivery are considered and actions are taken to improve. Suggestions which are related to change in curriculum or syllabus are informed to BOS / MUHS / respective councils.

#### 1. Academic Performance and University Results

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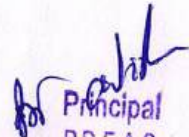
