Sir/Madam,

1. To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college and inspection was conducted on **01.06.2026 and 02.06.2026 on Hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process **for extended permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 68 seats in 14 PG courses in the subject namely (i) Ayurved Samhita, Sanskrit & Siddhant- 02 seats (ii) Kriya Sharir- 06 seats (iii) Dravyaguna Vigyana-02 seats (iv) Rasa Shastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana-06 seats (v) Kaumarbhritya-Bala Roga-06 seats (vi) Shalya Tantra-06 seats (vii) Shalakya Tantra(EYE-03 SEATS AND ENT-03 SEATS)-06 seats (viii) Kayachikitsa-06 seats (ix) Panchkarma-02 seats, (x)Stri Roga -02 seats (xi) Swasthvritha-06 seats (xii)Rog Nidan avum vikriti vigyan-06 seats (xiii) Agad tantra avum vidhi vaidyaka-06 seats (xiv) Rachana sharir-06 seats, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2026-27.**
2. The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and relevant Regulations thereunder. **On careful examination of the assessment report shortcomings/defects were observed** and the same was placed in the **167<sup>th</sup> Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **30.07.2026**. Board discussed and decided to **seek Clarification from the college regarding the shortcomings deficiencies observed during the assessment.**
3. Further, an opportunity of clarification vide letter even no. dated 22.08.2026 was provided to you. In response of the same you have submitted the clarification vide ref. no.- 1493/2026-27 dated 24.08.2026.
4. The Clarification was duly placed in the 175<sup>th</sup> Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 02.09.2026 and Board concluded that the college is fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of extended permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulation. Hence, the Board decided to issue extended permission for 60 seats in UG BAMS Course in accordance with Regulation 54 (2) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 and 68 seats in 14 PG Courses in the subject namely (i) Ayurved Samhita, Sanskrit & Siddhant- 02 seats (ii) Kriya Sharir- 06 seats (iii) Dravyaguna Vigyana-02 seats (iv) Rasa Shastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana-06 seats (v) Kaumarbhritya-Bala Roga-06 seats (vi) Shalya Tantra-06 seats (vii) Shalakya Tantra(EYE-03 SEATS AND ENT-03 SEATS)-06 seats (viii) Kayachikitsa-06 seats (ix) Panchkarma-02 seats, (x)Stri Roga -02 seats (xi) Swasthvritha-06 seats (xii)Rog Nidan avum vikriti vigyan-06 seats (xiii) Agad tantra avum vidhi vaidyaka-06 seats (xiv) Rachana sharir-06 seats in accordance with Regulation 15 (5) of MESAR PG Ayurveda 2024 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic year 2026-27 as the college has been permitted consecutively for previous three years after fulfilling the conditions as specified in the concerned Regulations.

**"DECISION"**

5. Therefore, **Extended permission for 60 seats in UG BAMS Course in accordance with Regulation 54 (2) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 and for 68 seats in 14 PG Courses in the subject namely (i) Ayurved Samhita, Sanskrit & Siddhant- 02 seats (ii) Kriya Sharir- 06 seats (iii) Dravyaguna Vigyana-02 seats (iv) Rasa Shastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana-06 seats (v) Kaumarbhritya-Bala Roga-06 seats (vi) Shalya Tantra-06 seats (vii) Shalakya Tantra(EYE-03 SEATS AND ENT-03 SEATS)-06 seats (viii) Kayachikitsa-06 seats (ix) Panchkarma-02 seats, (x) Stri Roga -02 seats (xi) Swasthvritta-06 seats (xii) Rog Nidan avum vikriti vigyan-06 seats (xiii) Agad tantra avum vidhi vaidyaka-06 seats (xiv) Rachana sharir-06 seats in accordance with Regulation 15(5) of MESAR PG Ayurveda 2024 is hereby issued to Pune District Education Associations, College of Ayurveda & Research Centre, Sector No.25, Pradhikaran, Near Vitthal Rukmini, Pune-411044, Maharashtra (AYU0149) academic session 2026-27, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that following requirements shall be fulfilled.**

- I. It is informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity 68 seats in 14 PG courses** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2026-27 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder**
6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
7. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
8. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
9. **Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.**
10. **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2026 and compliance report should be submitted to MARBISM in order to be considered for the process of the permission for the academic session 2027-2028 as per rules:**
- All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
  - All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
  - All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
  - All the requirements of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda, Regulations, 2024
11. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the renewal of permission for the academic session 2027-28.

**Note: - It is also noted that, if the concerned University does not grant affiliation to the college or withdraws the affiliation, the permission granted by MARBISM shall automatically stand withdrawn without any further notice or order.**
